<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be continuing with our work on multiplication and division and then onto measurement – length and height, mass and capacity</p>	<p>English</p> <p>The Lighthouse Keeper’s Lunch will be the book to inspire our writing journey using the Jane Considine writing approach. The children will plan and write their own narrative</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>The class will continue with the subject of animals looking at food chains. We will look at the different roles played by plants and animals</p>
<p>History/Geography</p> <p>How did we learn to fly? Year 2 will be learning all about the history of flight and who the significant people were.</p>	<p>Art/ DT</p> <p>In DT the children will be designing a healthy smoothie for Mrs Virnuls. They will then be making the smoothie, testing it and then evaluating their product</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>The class will be answering these two main questions - How and why do we celebrate significant times? What makes some celebrations sacred to believers?</p>
<p>Computing</p> <p>The children will be learning about spreadsheets while using Purple Mash</p>	<p>P.S.H.E.</p> <p>This term we will be learning about ‘Healthy Me’. The children will be learning about food, exercise and how to have a healthy mind</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>Our unit of work this term is called ‘Zoo time’. We will be learning a song in a Reggae style, where we will play instruments, improvise, compose and perform</p>
